Access to Set-Asides: Compete for federal contracts reserved specifically for womenowned businesses.

National Recognition: Gain official designation with the SBA and federal procurement officers


Increased Visibility: Get listed in the Dynamic Small Business Search (DSBS), used by government buyers

To qualify for WOSB certification, your business must be at least 51% unconditionally and directly owned by one or more women who are U.S. citizens. These women must manage daily operations and make longterm decisions.

For EDWOSB (Economically Disadvantaged WOSB), the woman owner must also:

- Have a personal net worth of less than \$850,000
- Have an adjusted gross income under \$400,000 (averaged over 3 years)
- Hold total assets not exceeding \$6.5 million

These requirements ensure the business is truly woman-owned, controlled, and economically disadvantaged according to SBA guidelines.
